### **Challenge Trophy:**

**Cedarpoint Best of Winners Challenge Trophy** - this trophy will be presented to the same breeder(s) who win Best Of Winners for 3 consecutive years in a row. Does not necessarily need to be with the same dog.

## **JUVENILE & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

The Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of Canada will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% will be awarded as follows:  
BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES 50% of Overall Entry & Rosette & Prize  
BEST OF OPPOSITE TO BEST IN SWEEPS 25% of Overall Entry & Rosette & Prize.

1<sup>st</sup> in each class will receive a Prize and Rosette.

2<sup>nd</sup>–4<sup>th</sup> Class Placements will receive a Prize and Ribbon.

## **CLASSIFICATIONS**

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

- Junior Puppy for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age  
Senior Puppy for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age  
12-18 Months..... for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age  
Canadian Bred..... for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded  
Bred By Exhibitor... for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards  
Open..... for all dogs.  
Veteran..... for any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. **DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.**  
Specials Only..... for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is not allowed.  
Exhibition Only..... dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.  
Exhibition Only ... puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades.

## **NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES**

### **Juvenile Sweepstakes**

To Compete In Juvenile Sweepstakes Class, Dogs Must Be Entered In a Regular Class, Or For Specials Only. Entry In Juvenile Sweepstakes From The Exhibition Only Class Is Not Allowed.

Classes will be divided by age only as follows:

6-9 months      9-12 Months      12-18 months

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, veterans class, Specials Only, or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following Non-Regular Classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

**Veteran Sweepstakes** Classes will be divided by age & sex as follows:

7-9 Years      9-11 years      11 years & older

**Brace** Two dogs of one breed (either sex or mixed) not necessarily owned by the same owner, shown by one handler on one lead.

**Stud Dog & Get** Stud Dog and 2 or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

**Brood Bitch & Progeny** Brood Bitch and 2 or more of her Progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner

**Juniors** Junior handling will be after Sweeps. Info at the Hospitality tent

**PARADE OF VETERANS** Dogs must be 7 years of age or older (not necessarily champions). Dogs must be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only. **Please supply a short biography of each dog entered.**

**Please note:** An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7.

### ***ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS***

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$57.75 + GST (7%). ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.** A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca>
